



CURRICULUM

LaSal Teatro was born in Granada, January 1999 and is the brainchild of two-people - Rosa Diaz and Julia Ruiz.

LaSal Teatro began its activity with a show called **Cómeme cruda (Eat me Raw)** in the **Theatre Fair of Palma del Rio** (Cordoba), June 1999. It was also presented in October of the same year at **the II Iberoamerican Theatre Festival**, Santo Domingo (Dominic Republic).

This performance was awarded the **BEST PERFORMANCE** and **BEST ACTRESS (Julia Ruiz)** Awards in **La Nave del Teatro de Chiclana** (Cadiz).

Zapatos (Shoes) is a show for children from 3 to 6 years old. First presented at TEATRALIA, in March 2000, it has to date been represented almost 300 times and has been translated into Catalan and Basque. **LaSal Teatro** was nominated for a **MAX AWARD in 2002** with this performance as a Revelation Company.

Since February 2002, **LaSal Teatro** has been working with **El Gran Traje (The Great Outfit)**. With about 300, the first performance was at the Theatre Fair for children **FETEN 2002** where it was awarded with the **BEST STAGE DESIGN**.

The Great Outfit was nominated for **REVELATION PERFORMANCE** in the 2003 **MAX AWARDS** and it has been present at the **12th International Puppet Theatre Festival** in Plovdiv (Bulgaria), September 2003.

The latest performance of **LaSal Teatro** is **Aguaire**. It tells the story about an impossible love. The story of a fish and a fisherman for children from 7 upwards and has been represented about 150 times all around Spain winning the following awards:

On 4th July 2006 *La Vieja Durmiente (The Sleeping Old Woman)* opened. Written and directed by Julia Ruiz in the context of the Palma del Río Theatre Fair, where it obtained great critical and public success. The play won the **Best Female Interpretation (Lola Martín)**.

In July 2007 *LaSaL* was contracted by the International Spanish Cooperation Agency, which depends on the Spanish Ministry of Foreign Affairs, to do an international tour through Mexico, Guatemala, Nicaragua and El Salvador with *The Great Outfit*.

In February 2008 *Lalú* opened in **FETEN** (European Children Theatre Fair) - the first company performance for babies 1 to 3 years old.

On 12th August 2008 at the Arbolé Theatre in Zaragoza, *LaSaL* showed the play *La Voz Se Me Hace Agua (My voice seems like water)* for children which are between 6 and 12 years old, staying in the line-up for three weeks with a great public appreciation.

On 8th May 2010 *LaSaL* showed its last play *Soy Solo (Be Alone)* for children which are between 5 and 10 years old. This new show is a new experience which includes magic as a scenic language.
